

Greenbrier Soccer Club and Park Policies

Coaches and Parents please help the Greenbrier Soccer Club enforce the following policies at the club soccer fields.

1. All players **MUST** wear shin guards during games AND practice. This is a state insurance requirement. An injury resulting from not wearing a shin guard could result in the club losing state insurance.
2. Player Dress Code at all times on the fields will be appropriate soccer game attire. All practice attire should be equivalent to game attire. If a referee would not let you wear in it a game it should not be worn at practice. The basic tenant is that you practice as you play and you will be better prepared for the games.
3. Please protect our fields. Try to do as much off the field as possible. Especially try to stay out from in front of the goals. We all like to have nice grass in front of our goals. This is especially important in the spring with wet ground and the Bermuda grass is not growing until later in the season.
4. Please protect our equipment and the kids. The kids should never climb on the goals. This is a safety concern and helps maintain the integrity of our equipment. This definitely includes the small rebound goals which cost \$500 each. Nets can cost around \$200 each.
5. Please pick up after practice/games. Help keep the park looking good. Also we could use some volunteers to help empty the trash cans each week.
